Fantinel, Pinot Grigio, Friuli, Italy, 2009

Pinot Grigio with attitude! Pear and apple, with floral aromas dominate the nose which echoes the lively tangy freshness of the well balanced palate.

Louis Jardot, Chardonnay-Aligoté Coteaux Bourguignons Blanc, 2015



Errázuriz Pinot Noir Wild Ferment, Casablanca Valley, Chile, 2012



Barolo Lo Zoccolaio, Domini Villa Lanata, Italy, 2009

The Nebbiolo vineyards of Lo Zoccolaio are situated in the village of Barolo itself. This superior selection has been matured in the traditional way for three years in large old oak barrels before bottling. A wine with great complexity and smoothness. It has a concentrated bouquet composed of sour black cherry, blackcurrant and soft vanilla. On the palate flavours of coffee and black fruit can be found. A fine length with very elegant soft tannins.


